Access & Directions

The test range and check-in station are not within the base perimeter, but still require access controls. While the most efficient route to check-in station is through the base, you **WILL NOT BE ABLE TO TAKE THIS ROUTE WITHOUT AN ACTIVE MILITARY ID**. See below for specific instructions.

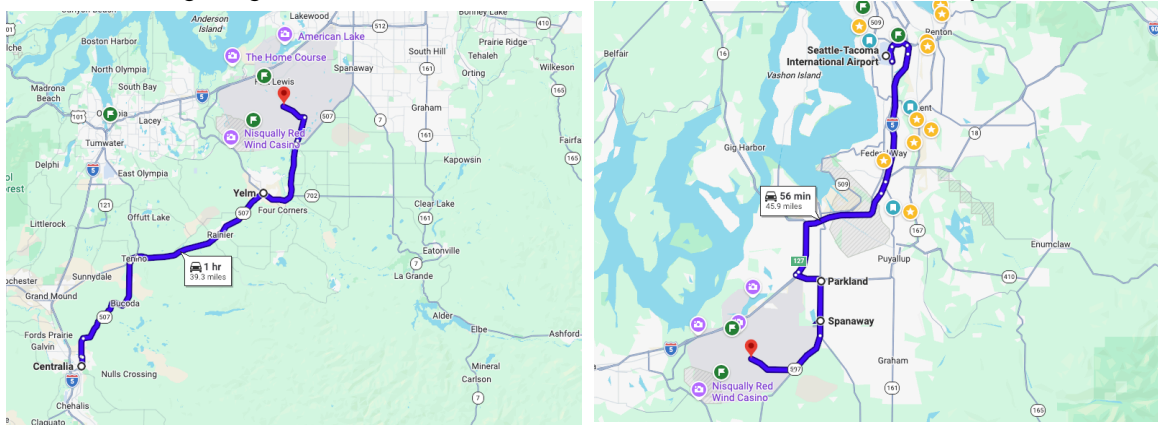
If YOU **DO NOT** HAVE AN ACTIVE MILITARY ID (ie CAC Card):

The FIFA Field-Ready Range Day is held off-base of Joint Base Lewis-McChord. If you put the landmark directions in Google Maps or other navigation service, the directions will likely take you through JBLM gates.

If you do not have an active military ID you will not be able to enter the JBLM gate & will be turned around.

Access to the Check in location is possible without requiring base access; however, you will need to follow these directions.

All directions route you to the check in station at the “[C5 Mockup](#)” landmark for processing, safety brief, and range directions.

IF YOU HAVE AN ACTIVE MILITARY ID

If you have a valid Military ID Google Map Instructions will work well. Navigate through any JBLM gate and proceed to the check in station at the “[C5 Mockup](#)” for processing, safety brief, and range directions.
